The Roman villa of Mutteron dei Frati (Bibione, VE) and the surrounding landscape 17thMarch - 11thApril 2025

In Roman times the villa was located on a coastal lido between the sea and the inland lagoons. The building was built in a protected and strategic position: at the foot of sandy dunes, near both the mouth of the river *Tiliaventum Minus* and a harbour mouth that allowed boats to pass through and trade.Ongoing research is revealing a large, articulated and richly decorated residential sector. The productive sector, as well as the harbour and landing facilities, have not yet been identified. Join the excavation to contribute to the research!

The Bibione Project, funded by the DFG, sees the collaboration of the University of Regensburg, the University of Padua and the Ministry of Culture.

All students in archaeology (B.A., M.A., Specializzandi and Phd) can apply for the activity. Medical examination and safety course certificate for ar-

chaeological activities are prerequisites for participation. Board and lodging are provided.
